March 2010 release from IngentaConnect

We have just released a new version of IngentaConnect, this latest release includes:

Shibboleth 2.0 compliance

IngentaConnect not only now supports Shibboleth 2 for institutions within the UK Federation, but will also maintain access for institutions on older versions, via it's OpenAthens SP authentication system. To enable Shibboleth access for your institution please contact our [Customer Service team](#) providing your Shibboleth entity ID and your IngentaConnect customer ID or administrator username.

Open Access support

An Open Access flag has been added to IngentaConnect to make a clear distinction between free and Open Access content.

Improved visibility of purchase and download options.

Based on your feedback the download and pay-per-view options are now located at the top of each abstract page.

Integration of Rightsconnect with IngentaConnect.

IngentaConnect is now integrated with Rightsconnect allowing users to obtain permission for re-use directly via the site. A 'Get Permissions' link now appears on each abstract page, which directs users to the Copyright Clearance Center to obtain permission for reuse.

The Institute stems from the personal library of the Hamburg scholar Aby Warburg (1866-1929), whose research centred on the intellectual and social context of Renaissance art.

IAJ is a new journal, resurrecting the old Sudanic Africa journal from some decades ago. Northwestern is home to one of the most prestigious African studies departments and probably the leading Africana library in the US.
